

# National Museum of the Civil War Soldier

Architect for new building

The project is designed to celebrate the life and work of the ordinary soldier during the Civil War by coupling a distinctive building with compelling exhibits. The museum's white brick exterior contrasts with the surrounding woods. Rising high above the granite-paved entrance plaza, and clearly visible to arriving visitors, is a distinctive dome and cupola which serve as a beacon and a centerpiece to the building, capping the octagonal entrance lobby.
