Planning and Conceptual Design

The new 70,000-sq.ft. River Heritage Center is conceived as an icon building that appears to be part of the city as well as the river, cantilevering over the city's flood wall. Its site and mass evoke images of tugboats, reinforcing Paducah's place as the hub of the world's greatest river transportation industry. Undulating blue bands flow around its sloped silver form like a wave around a ship's bow.
