## Planning and Conceptual Design

The 212,000-sq.ft. South Carolina State Museum is located in the handsome Mount Vernon Mills Building which dates to the 1890's, when it originally housed the nation's first electric-powered textile mill. The museum's 79,000-sq.ft. of exhibition space houses exhibits which tell the story of the history, natural history, science, technology, and art of the State of South Carolina.
